It is our intention to gain the attention of godly men and women willing to prayerfully devote time, energy and/or financial resources for the growth of the church in Cameroon in another dimension.

This brochure introduces you to the CAMEROON MULTIPURPOSE DREAMT CENTER, hereafter referred as CMDC: In 1971, the government of Cameroon gave the church a presidential decree backed by the church's commitment to be involved in the health and educational sectors to help the people of Cameroon. Up to this point, the church could not keep its promise.

### THE DREAM

Louis and Linda visited Ghana in 2021 to attend a workshop by the Gospel Chariot Mission at the Village of Hope, a multipurpose center owned by the church. They immediately realized how the church in Cameroon could keep its commitment to the government and support the mission of the church.



Once in Cameroon, Louis and Linda took a tour around the country to share this vision with a few families in the church. The dream was bought!

### WHAT IS MISSING?

- The decree of the church is being threatened today due to its use by other religious groups. The government is unwilling to resolve the matter since the church has failed to meet the commitments outlined in the decree.
- The church of Christ is unknown in the socio-cultural field, not able to provide facilities where Christian children and practitioners can perform with Bible virtues and principles.
- There is no church affiliated retreat center or camp facility.
- There is no strategy for medical outreach with a gospel impact.

Consequently, we are very anxious to start the Village of Hope's model of a children's home, a medical center, a retreat facility, a multipurpose hall and a higher institution of learning.

We do acknowledge the few individuals whose efforts have established orphanages and schools in the country, but they are not registered under the church's governmental decree, and as such carry no weight toward fulfilling the commitments contained therein.

We also acknowledge the Cameroon Mobile Clinic which operated in the 1970s but was later closed when the government passed a decree requiring that to run a mobile clinic, you must first have a stationary one.

## CONCRETE ACTIONS

- **Project Management**

1. Ownership: Cameroon CoC
2. Accountability: Elected BoD
3. Supervision: Camwork
4. Operations: Recruited Personnel

- **Beneficiary:** Church & Public

- **The Families**

13 families have donated \$8,570 toward the CMDC. This money was used toward the purchase of land.

- **First Phase**

A piece of land (~5 acres) has been purchased in the Muyuka Mbanga village.

- **Second Phase**

1. Raise additional XAF \$5,400 for land expansion. (Done)
2. Amend the road to the site, meanwhile the land could be cultivated for food crops.
3. Publicize the project and bring more individuals and families on board.

- **Third Phase**

1. Set up a health clinic
2. Establish a children's home
3. Build retreat /camp housing
4. Build boarding school and college
5. Large multipurpose meeting hall

## SUMMARY

The Goal of the Cameroonian brothers and sisters is to Create and Run a Multipurpose Center called CMDC - Cameroon Multipurpose Dreamt Center.

Thirteen families have teamed up already and a piece of land has been purchased.

It is their prayer and expectation that many others will come on board.
