The Bassay family got their US visas on 7th of July. They will leave Cameroon on the 18th of July to return on the 5th of October. All credits to God Almighty with special thanks to the Cloverdale Family. YEP– VBS is ongoing and will continue in the absence of the Bassays. This report covers the trip to the republic of Chad, the National Preachers' Forum, the Visit of Jerry and Dianne Myhan from Cloverdale, the Soul Saving Mission to Kake and the campaign led by Jim Corner from Dallas, TX.

ACTIVITIES

SEMINAR IN THE REPUBLIC OF CHAD (MAY 1 - 4)

A Macedonian call from Jude Robenate, one of Louis' students from Bear Valley Bible Institute Mbanga, Cameroon who returned to his home town at Koumra in the republic of Chad in March 2021. Louis and Linda finally made the decision to go help. They had 4 days of intense discipleship for men by Louis and the training of Sunday school teachers by Linda. The Teaching was in French and translated in their local language and sometimes sign language. A copy of Noble Age, the children's curriculum written by Louis and Linda was given to each congregation represented. They enjoyed hospitality and fellowship. Though exhausted from the very long road trip (Two days each way) and high temperatures, to God be the glory for a successful seminar: 102 participants from 10 congregations, 52 women and 50 men, and one baptism.



THE NATIONAL PREACHERS' FORUM (MAY 28-31)

The Preachers' Forum was held in Bonaberi church of Christ directed by Louis from May 28th to 31st, 2025. It brought together 90 preachers from 66 congregations across Cameroon.

Their theme was "Rekindling Our Ministerial DEAL (2 Timothy 4:1–5)." with key discussions centered on Duty, Ethics, Authority and Leadership. The forum served as a time of renewal, reflection, and strengthening. Iron sharpens iron.



THE VISIT OF JERRY AND DIANNE MYHAN (MAY 29-JUNE 5)

Jerry serves as one of the elders at Cloverdale and this was his second trip to Cameroon to visit with the Bassays. Dianne was on her first visit. They almost did not make it because the complicated Cameroon visa system, but God has multiple ways to remind his people of His position on the throne. Their time in Cameroon was that of encouragement to the Bassays, seeing what they do and meeting with some of the people involved in the work in Cameroon. Such visits are also a demonstration of the Cloverdale intentional commitment in the life of their missionary families and a great example to the people they serve. One important thing with Jerry and Dianne was the advisory moments. Glory to God for their simplicity that made hosting them in the Bassay's home so enjoyable.

JIM CORNER CAMPAIGN (JUNE 8-15)

Jim Corner visits Cameroon three times a year and each time Louis and Linda are involved. This June they worked with 7 congregations, had 38 studies, 19 baptisms and 2 restorations. As a result of this mission, two brothers, Daniel and Sinclair, were baptized and added to the Bomono Congregation. Daniel is blind and Sinclair is happy leading his way every day.



SOULS SAVING MINISTRY - SSM (JUNE 12-15)

The team is happy for Camwork and the Cloverdale family for making all provisions needed for the mission. Special recognition to Bobby Dockery and the Gospel Tract International for the tracts and preaching materials they have sent to the Bassays and their work. The SSM has worked this year in BO-MONO (23rd to 26th of January with 1 baptism) in BONABERI (12th to 15th



of March with zero baptism) and in KAKE (12th to 15th of June with 1 baptism and 3 Restorations). Louis was not fully a part of the Kake work as this was going on alongside Jim Corner's campaign.



YEP - VBS

The Youth Engagement Program - Vacation Bible School started on the 24th of June and will run through the month of July depending on each of the 7 locations selected this year. Linda has put in place regional leaders who will keep the program running even while the Bassays are away for furlough. Much about YEP-VBS 2025 is being uploaded on Facebook regularly. Funding from congregations and individuals in Cameroon is also timely this year. A comprehensive report will be published next month.
